Atleast 90 faculty members should be available for engaging the class work. It was stressed that steps should be taken on priority basis to recruit the faculty at the earliest.

Principal strongly pleaded that substantial funds to the tune of Rs. 1100.00 lacs should be released in 1998-99 to complete the infrastructural needs i.e. buildings, roads, services, equipment and machinery for the college.

An amount of Rs. 149.12 lacs has been spent on equipment, machinery and books as on 31.3.1998 against a provision of 875.00 lacs in the detailed project report of the college. Lack of equipment in the laboratories is largely on account of non availability of funds. This is adversely affecting teaching - learning programmes in the college.

With the admission of 1998 the total strength of students will go up to 900. Faculty of 40 regular teachers at all level is in position on date and is grossly inadequate to meet the teaching requirements as per the norms laid down by the AICTE. At least 90 faculty members should be available for engaging the class work. It was stressed that steps should be taken on priority basis to recruit the faculty at the earliest.

Principal strongly pleaded that substantial funds to the tune of Rs. 1100.00 lacs should be released in 1998-99 to complete the infrastructural needs i.e. buildings, roads, services, equipment and machinery for the college.

(A Govt. of India Undertaking) on turn key basis and an agreement was signed on 29.6.94. The construction work of the college buildings was started on 17.9.96. The college is spread over an area of 98.4 acres and is located on Moga Road at a distance of 4 km. from Ferozepur. The master layout plan for the college provided for a total plinth area of 58002 sq. metres as per details below:

### Land

Case for enhancement of cost of land has been decided by the Honourable Court. Rs.514.46 lacs are payable to the owners of the land as per letter of SDM-cum-L.A, Ferozpur (copy placed at annexure XVI), on page no.96.

### Machinery and Equipment

A sum of Rs.875.00 lacs is provided in the detailed project report of the college. An expenditure of Rs.156.31 lacs has been incurred as on 31-05-99 for creating laboratories.

Development work of laboratories is suffering badly as purchases of required equipment are not made due to non availability of sufficient funds. Detail is placed at annexure XVII on page no 97.

### Books and Library

A total of 6200 text books have been procured for the use of students and teachers. 87 journals/periodicals/magazines and 335 ISI codes/workshop manuals and Twelve newspapers are being received in the reading room of the library.

It is added that as per norms fixed by AICTE 11312 books are needed, but required number of book are not purchased for wants of fund.

### Vehicles

The college has one ambassdor car, one TATA 1510 bus (52 seater), one mini bus(33 seater) and a M & M Commander jeep.

One tractor and an ambulance were approved by the Finance Committee during year 1997-98. But these could not be purchased due to the shortage of funds.



### Academic Programmes

The first academic session of the college was started on 21.08.95 and first batch (1995 admissions) of one hundred and twenty students is passing out in June/July 1999. Admissions to all the six B.TECH. degree programmes were made through CET entrance test. LEET students are also admitted to the college. AICTE inspection team visited the college on 26-04-99 for approval for 1999-2000.

Inadequate provision of funds & delayed release of instalments of grants-in-aid are posing serious problems in meeting our time schedule targets resulting in delays in completion of buildings and procurement of equipment and machinery. This is resulting in adverse observations by AICTE.

The college has started coaching classes to guide and prepare candidates who are appearing in the CET examination.

The budget estimates of Rs.2011.93 lacs including additional demand of Rs.1427.17 lacs ( Rs.742.43 lacs under urgent demand and Rs.684.44 lacs under other demand) has been approved for the year 1999-2000 by the Finance Committee of the College in its Seventh Meeting held on 08-06-99.
