A meeting of Board of Studies of Electrical Engineering Department was held on 20.05.16 in the office of HOD EED at 10:00 a.m. Following members attended the meeting-

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Member secretary extended the heartiest welcome to all the members of board of studies. The agenda items were put up in front of the board with the permission of Honorable chairman BOS.

## Item no. 2.1

The proposed course scheme attached as Annexure 1 was thoroughly discussed and deliberated upon. Suggestions made by Hon'ble Chairman BOS and other members are as such-

- Professional Skills Course should be treated as two hours group wise class/ practical work/ skill development training instead of conventional one hour lecture.
- 2. For 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4th and 5<sup>th</sup> semesters the contact hours should be increased to atleast 26-28 hours per week along with corresponding revision in credits. The same should be comparatively less for 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> semesters so that the students can devote more time to projects, self study and preparation for competitive exams.
- Course Power System II along with Laboratory should be shifted from 6<sup>th</sup> semester to 5<sup>th</sup> semester as Power System II is pre-requisite for Power System Analysis course which is also offered in 6<sup>th</sup> semester.
- 4. The options in Department Elective Subjects should be offered from interdisciplinary domains and new subjects like Signals & Systems, Power Quality, Digital Signal Processing and Process Dynamics & Control etc. etc. should also be offered in options.
- 5. Application based software/ Programming Language based subjects should be included in the course scheme of the program.
- 6. When the scheme was examined carefully, it was felt that 180 credits are not sufficient for incorporating all the necessary subjects required for GATE, IES, Corporate Sector and other competitive exams. Hence the institute should rethink about fixation of credits to 180 and revise the same after discussing the matter at the suitable forum.

7. As the Institute is AICTE approved, the course scheme and student contact hours should be strictly as per AICTE guidelines/ norms.

## Item no. 2.2

1. The syllabus contents, course outcomes and books recommended for 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> semesters proposed by Electrical Department are accepted and recommended.

It was unanimously decided to call another meeting on this issue after taking into account the above mentioned suggestions.
