Item No. 2.06

Approval for Honorarium to committee members/experts other than BOG members.

During 1st BOG meeting, it was proposed that Honorarium of Rs. 5000/- (Five Thousand Only) and travelling allowance as per rule may be allowed to pay the experts/members, the item was approved and it was decided that no honorarium will be paid to the official members.

Further, it is informed that sometimes external members/experts are included as members of a committee and as such no rules are available for payment of Honorarium/TA/DA to them. It is proposed that Honorarium of Rs. 3,000/- (Three thousand only) per meeting and not exceeding Rs. 5000/- per day and travelling allowance @ Rs. 10 per km may be allowed to pay to the external committee members.

At the outset, Sh Jatinder Kumar Aggarwal, Registrar Shaheed Bhagat Singh State University, Ferozepur welcomed the Hon'ble Chairman and Esteemed Members to the 1st Meeting of Finance Committee. Thereafter,

with the permission of Chair, the Agenda of 1st Finance Committee was deliberated upon and the following decisions were taken unanimously.

Item No. 1.01: Approval of Budget for FY 2021-2022 – Regarding

Decision:

a)

i) Salary budget was approved for four months. The budget for the subsequent period will be put up in the next FC meeting for approval.

ii) While discussing the salary budget Finance Dept representative pointed about special pay given to some employees of the institute. The Registrar clarified that these had been given as approved by BOG of the Institute.

iii) During discussion, representative of PSTE/IT has observed that some of the departments at university has surplus faculty as compared to the admissions in their department so it was recommended to rationalise the teaching and non-teaching staff as well as those hired through service provider to reduce the financial burden and to make university financially viable. Further it was also decided to follow Punjab Government/UGC/AICTE norms to release the salary and other allowances. This may be done in the next four months with the approval and advice of the BOG.

b) Rest of the Budget including Development fund, Student Activities and Examination fund was approved with an advice to minimise the expenditure to the extent



possible and only necessary expenditure should be done.

Item No. 1.02: New Scholarship Scheme in SBSSU, Ferozepur – Regarding.


Decision: Keeping in mind the financial position of the SBSSU, Finance Committee agreed in principle to implement the New Scholarship Scheme. Since the old scholarship scheme was approved by BOG, hence it was decided to get the approval of BoG for this.

Further FC has authorised Vice Chancellor to do the following on Pilot test basis:


- i) Give the scholarship upto 50% of tuition fee to the international students.
- ii) To Sign a MoU for admissions and to give a Brand Promotional Allowance upto 15% of tuition fee to a company/Organisation on the assurance of minimum 50 admissions of international students.

Meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.

Subject: Approval of Fee Structure for 2021-22 – Regarding

With reference to the above cited subject, a committee was constituted vide Office order No. SBS/FZR/567, dated: 17-05-2021 (ANNEXURE-A) to finalize the fee structures, Eligibility Criteria and Seat Matrix for the newly introduced courses of the University. Accordingly, the committee has prepared the detailed Fee structures and Eligibility Criteria as per details given below:

1. The Finalization of Fee Structures of new courses is attached as ANNEXURE-B. The restructuring of existing fee structures of Old courses has been done without increasing/decreasing the existing total fee amount. However, minor adjustment has been made while finalizing some sub components of the fee structure.
2. The Eligibility Criteria of all the existing courses has been kept as per IKGPTU/Punjab Govt. notification (ANNEXURE-C). The eligibility criteria of new courses which are not being run by IKGPTU/MRSPTU has been finalized at the SBSSU level by the committee. This will be got approved by the Board of Studies of the concerned department.
3. The Fee Structure of International Students has been finalized by referring the fee structure of IKGPTU, Jalandhar and is attached as ANNEXURE-D.

It is submitted for your kind approval so that the same could be notified for Admissions 2021 and Registration of students of existing batches.
