Item No.18.4 Budget Estimate for the year 2008-09.

The budget estimate for the financial year 2008-09 has been prepared keeping in view the decisions of 16th Finance Committee (Item No. 15.4) . The budget proposal has been drafted to improve the academic facilities in the college..

The college is offering the following B.Tech. Programmes. The intake in various disciplines for academic session 2008-09 is as under:

In addition 27 students (09 students in each of Computer Science & Engg., Electronic Communication Engg. & Mechanical Engg.) are admitted under 'tuition fee waiver scheme'. Another 10% of sanctioned strength is admitted in each discipline in 2nd year though Lateral Entry Scheme for Diploma holders.

All these courses have been approved by AICTE subject to creation of necessary facilities and infrastructure. Due to non-receipt of sufficient funds/Grant-in-aid from the Punjab Govt. the construction of buildings and purchase of relevant machinery and equipment suffered a set back. The academic activity related to Laboratory Class demonstration and training which is so vital and crucial to professional education is suffering irreparably at the cost of academic health of the students, for want of sufficient funds. Funds are urgently needed to meet the necessary requirements of buildings and machinery.

The balance sheet for the financial year 2007-2008 prepared by the college Chartered Accountant is attached at page no.29-31

Total strength of the students in the Academic year 2007-08 was 1290 against the sanctioned intake of 1505 for the year. The expected income of the college if all seats of 1st year & 2nd year LEET gets filled would be Rs.600.00 lacs.

The college has not been receiving any grant from the Punjab Govt. for the last four years. Besides, the college received inadequate grant in aid from the year 1996-97 .

In the proposed budget estimate Rs. 1518.63 lacs has been demanded under special Grant in Aid (Refer p.11)

The budget estimates for the financial year 2008-09 are placed before the Finance Committee for its consideration, and necessary approval please.

Justification for Expenditure (for 2008-2009)

A. Non-Recurring Expenditure

1. Building & Development Works

A sum of Rs.2404.24 lacs (ref. P.9 Sr.No.A(2) Col. 5 has already been spent upto 31.3.2008.

Keeping in view the inadequate grant allocated/released by the Punjab Govt. to this college in financial year 2001-2002 to 2007-2008 , a total sum of Rs.1926.00 lacs (ref. P.9 is now being demanded.

The details of proposed construction of buildings are placed at P.12. The construction of buildings and other Development Infrastructure is essential and is unavoidable as per norms of AICTE. It is further added that the construction work was scheduled to be completed by Oct.97, but the same could not be completed due to meager allocation of funds, during the year 1996-97, 1997-98, 1998-99, 1999-2000, 2001-2002 and Rs. Nil in 2002-03 to 2007-08 . Because of paucity of funds the construction work has suffered badly. And the project cost has escalated by more than 50% owing to increased cost of materials & labour from 1995 to 2008 @ 10% per annum. The case for an enhancement of the amount already provided in the Project Report will be taken up separately.

2. Machinery & Equipment

A sum of Rs.389.13(ref.p.9 Sr. No.A(3), col 2) have been spent upto 31.3.2007, and only Rs.44.90 lacs (ref. P.9 Sr.No.A(3) col 4) was spent during the financial year 2007-2008 against the approved budget estimate of Rs.131.08 lacs.(ref. P.9 Sr.No. A(3) col.3).

It is stated that due to non-availability of funds the process of purchase of machinery and equipment has suffered badly and hence the development of laboratory infrastructure is totally incomplete. It is adversely affecting the technical/professional training of the students.

The details of the money required by different departments for the purchase of machinery and equipment are given at page no.13, Rs.136.00 lacs as proposed in the budget estimate for the year 2008-09 is thus, justified for the infrastructure development of the college and in the interest of the professional and Technical training and teaching of the students.

3. Other facilities (ref P.9 Sr.No.A(4))

Rs.137.85 lacs(ref. P.9 Sr.No. A(4) Col. 2) have been incurred upto 31.3.2007. These facilities are essential and are required as per Project Report. But the same could not be provided due to non-availability of funds. Rs.6.62 lacs(ref. P.9 Sr.No.A(4) Col.4 have only been spent during the financial year 2007-2008 against the approved budget estimate of Rs.22.00 lacs. (ref. P.9 Sr.No.A(4)).

An amount of Rs 22.00 lacs is proposed in the budget estimate for the financial year 2008-2009, is thus, justified for the infrastructure development of the College.

B(a) Recurring Expenditure

1. Pay and Allowances (ref. P.9, Sr.No.B(a)1)

A sum of Rs.365.01 lacs was incurred during the financial year 2007-2008 against the approved budget estimate of Rs.428.24 lacs as proposed in the Budget Estimate for that financial year.

Rs.538.58 lacs are required for the payment of pay and allowances (ref. P.9 Sr.No.B(a) 1, col 6 and P.20-28). The amount proposed is therefore justified.

2. T.A/D.A & L.T.C. (ref. P.9 Sr.No.B (a) 2

A sum of Rs.1.80 lac had been incurred during the financial year 2007-08 for TA/DA & L.T.C against the approved budget estimate of Rs.1.50 lacs.

Rs.1.50 lacs have been proposed in the budget estimate (ref. P.9) for the financial year 2008-2009. The amount demanded for the proposed expenditure is justified,. Keeping in view the strength of the teaching and the non-teaching staff.

3. Medical Reimbursement (ref p.9, Sr.No.B (3))

A sum of Rs.1.63 lacs had been incurred during the financial year 2007-2008 against the approved budget estimate of Rs.3.30 lacs (ref. P.9).

A sum of Rs.3.30 lacs has been proposed in the Budget Estimate for the financial year 2008-2009 (ref. P.9) The proposed expenditure is justified keeping in view the medical reimbursement provided to the staff by the State Govt.

b. Other Contingencies (ref. P.10, Sr.No.B(b)

1. Water & Electricity

A sum of Rs.46.38 lacs had been incurred during the year 2007-2008 against the approved budget estimate of Rs.44.00 lacs. It is further added that a sum of Rs.8.07 lacs was recovered from the staff and shop- keepers on account of use of electricity power.

Rs.64.00 lacs are proposed in Budget Estimate for the Financial year 2008-2009, and the same is justified. In this proposal Rs.17.00 lacs is for enhancing electrical load from PSEB.

2. Telephone

A sum of Rs.0.63 lacs had been spent against the approved amount of Rs.1.50 lacs in the budget estimate of the year 2007-2008(P.10)

A sum of Rs.1.50 lacs has therefore again been proposed for the financial year 2008-2009 also (P.10) Telephones are installed in the offices/departments/hostels. Therefore the proposed expenditure is justified.

3. Vehicle repair and Maintenance

A sum of Rs.3.60 lacs had been incurred against the amount of Rs.4.50 lacs as approved in the budget estimate of the financial year 2007-2008.

A sum of Rs.4.50 lacs has now again been proposed in the budget estimate for the financial year 2008-2009. The proposal is made keeping in view the increasing prices of diesel and petrol etc. A sum of Rs.1.23 lacs was recovered on a/c of the private use of vehicles. The same amount (i.e.Rs.1.23 lacs) is expected to be recovered on a/c of private use of vehicle during the financial year 2008-2009.

A sum of Rs.15.16 lacs was spent against the approved Budget Estimate of Rs.14.00 lacs during the Financial Year 2007-2008.

A sum of Rs.28.00 lacs has therefore been proposed in the Budget Estimate for the Financial Year 2008-2009 also. In this proposal Rs.12.00 lac is for Brick lining of Sewerage oxidation ponds. This expenditure includes wages payable to the workers employed for the maintenance of buildings. The proposed expenditure is justified.

Security of Campus/Horticulture/House keeping ref. p.10 Sr.No. B(b) 19)

A sum of Rs.19.15 lacs was spent against the budget Estimate of Rs.16.50 lacs for the Financial Year 2007-2008. A sum of Rs.20.00 lacs approx. has been proposed for the budget estimate for the Financial Year 2008-2009 (ref. p.10) It is added that these services are engaged on contractual basis, at wages as fixed by the D.C. Ferozepur payable to the manpower engaged for this purpose. Thus the proposed expenditure is justified.

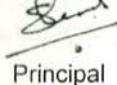

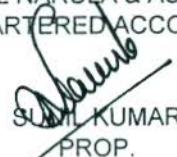

To write off the said equipment the case was put up in the 14th finance committee vide item no. 14.7(c) and the committee directed to send this separately so that the same be examined in detail and appropriate decision be taken.(Annexure – V, p 46.

The same was also put up in the 15 finance committee and was noted by the chairman and other members but the decision was not taken by the committee. (Annexure –VI, pp 47-48.

The case was sent separately by the college vide our letter no. SBS/FZR/1510-12,SBS/FZR16026-28, SBS/FZR1229-3 1 and SBS/FZR/8474 dated 22/5/6,11/10/6,13/4/7 and 16/1/8 respectively.(Annexure-VII, pp 49-52.

Now the college has got the guidelines from Director, Technical Education and Ind. Train., Punjab vide letter no.9/11/06-05 2/560 dated 29/2/08.. (Annexure –VIII, pp 53-54.)

As per the guidelines

“Since as per RBI guidelines, depreciation norms regarding computer equipment is 32% of the cost per year, may adopt this norms by calculating the depreciation on straight line method subject to the condition that disposal price in any case is not less then the 10% of the book value up to 5 years. Beyond 5 years, the department may dispose of the existing obsolete/unserviceable IT equipment in the market to the short listed vendors approved by Department of Information Technology. Punjab through restricted bidding or through the open bidding”

The equipment in question is more then 5 years old out of which 95% of the equipment was purchased 12 years ago and is obsolete/unserviceable, lying idle in the college.

The committee is requested to give the direction to write off/dispose of the said equipment.

Item no. 18.8: Sanction of Enhanced Connected Electrical Load in the College

The connected electrical load in the college premises has increased over the period of time due to establishment of new labs and introduction of new engineering branches. The details of the load so calculated are mentioned hereunder:

Sanctioned connected load of the college from PSEB = 1037 KW

Annexure - X, p 57.

A. Calculated increased connected load as on dated 9/5/06 = 450KW

Annexure - XI, p 58.

B. From 9/5/06 till date a number of new labs have been established in the various departments of the college.

The increase in connected load over and above that calculated on 9/5/06
= 106.1KW

C. In addition, some load is proposed to be connected/ commissioned shortly within a few months as the necessary installations in the various labs and departments are going on.

The proposed increase in the connected electrical load = 143.9 KW

The total increase in connected electrical load of the college (including the actual load on date and the proposed one) = A+B+C

= 450KW +106.1KW +143.9KW

= 700KW

The total connected load in the college is (sanctioned load + increased load)

= 1037KW + 700KW = 1737KW.

The approximate expenditure for getting this enhanced connected load (i.e. 700 KW) sanctioned from PSEB @ Rs.2350/- per kw. is Rs. Seventeen lacs (Rs. 17 lacs.)

Item no. 18.9: Brick Lining of Oxidation Sewerage Ponds

The sewerage water from the college premises flows into three solar oxidation ponds where some of it evaporates and the rest overflows the system. These tanks are earthen tanks without any lining. The approximate dimensions of these ponds are 165' x 130' x 8' each.

There had been an inspection of the college by Punjab Pollution Control Board on 8/4/08. As per the remarks and advice obtained from the Punjab Pollution Control Board, these oxidation ponds should be lined to stop any seepage into the ground from these ponds. Annexure XIII, pp 60-61.

The estimate has been prepared for brick lining of these oxidation ponds. The estimated expenditure for the lining of three oxidation ponds is Rs.Twelve lacs (Rs.12 lacs.)
