1. Institute has implemented 1st module of ERP solution provided by TCS for academic, accounts and recruitment of employees. Implementation of 2nd module is in progress.

2. The Institute has got a grant of Rs. 10 Crore from MHRD Govt of India for the Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme and Procurement is under full Swing. Presently in procurement, the Institute is leading all the Institutes of India which were selected under TEQIP-II and has spent about Rs. 5 Crore from its own resources in addition to Rs. 2 Crore received from Govt. of Punjab till date.

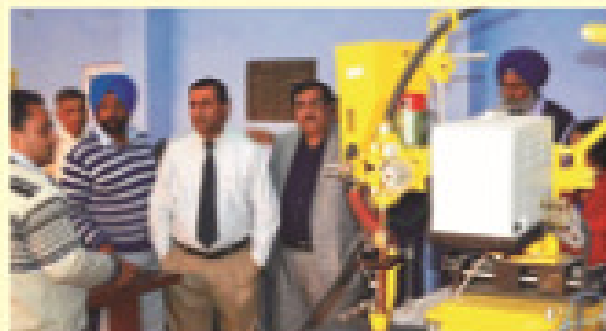


3. The Institute has also got a grant of Rs. 2 Crore from AICTE New Delhi for the construction of Boys Hostel for SC/ST Students and the construction has started. The institute will also spend Rs. 2 Crore from its own resources for the construction of Boys Hostel.



4. Work for the construction of 12 lecture halls and 12 tutorials rooms is near completion. Addition of 24 new lecture halls and tutorial rooms is a great achievement of the Institute.

5. One new girls' hostel is constructed with a cost of Rs. 5 crore which will be inaugurated on 18.02.2014 by Hon'ble Technical Education Minister Punjab. State-of-art Gymnasium, Common Room, Parks and Mess facilities will be given to students in this new hostel.



6. Various projects sponsored by AICTE/UGC worth Rs. 66 Lacs are in progress and Projects worth Rs.10 Lacs have been applied to AICTE for modernization of Labs.

7. Due to increased intake of students, they have been accommodated by modifying twelve D-Type houses and three A-Type houses as temporary hostels.

8. The institute has got Rs. 5 Lacs from Hon'ble Member of Parliament Sh. Sher Singh Ghubaiya ji and purchased machines for Gymnasium for fitness of students.



9. The DDO powers as well as approval of purchase powers were delegated to Head of Departments up to single purchase of Rs. 1 Lacs.



10. As desired by Sh. Anil Joshi Ji, Hon'ble Technical Education Minister Punjab, institute has planted more than 2000 shaded plants to beautify the campus.

11. 3500 sq ft parking area constructed for parking scooters of students near the Main Gate.

12. Thirty CCTV Cameras have been installed at strategic points throughout the campus and TV screens have been provided in HODs room for constant surveillance of student activities.

13. Corridors of three blocks and girls hostel were furnished with glazing tiles, to renovate the existing buildings for giving better look. Similarly all hostels have been renovated.



14. Soft skills and Personality Development classes were conducted for all branches to train them for campus interviews.

15. Footpaths on both sides of the main road were covered with interlocking tiles to facilitate the girl students for walking during summer and rainy days.



16. The DDO Powers and Approval Powers were delegated to Registrar for payment of salary, pension, loan, arrears and other service benefits to the employees of the institute as well as refund of security and fees to students.



17. A beautiful park in an area of about 10 acre has been developed with proper seating arrangements, fountain, and shed.

18. The Institute has applied to the NBA office for accreditation of five degree programmes and expert visit is awaited.

19. The Institute has applied to UGC for getting academic autonomy and expert visit is awaited. The Institute is actively pursuing the case with UGC for getting academic autonomy at the earliest possible.

20. The Hon'ble Cabinet Minister Sh Surjit Kumar Jiyan ji has announced to give Rs. 5 Lacs for the purpose of purchasing sports related machines.

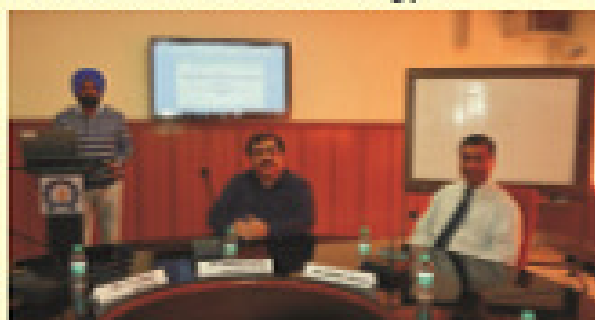


21. With the active contributions of its faculty, staff and students the Institute is striving hard to make it one of the best Institutes in the state of Punjab and making all round efforts to become deemed University by the end of year 2014.



22. Dr. Jan Borkent, Professor and Expert of PUM Institute of Netherlands has been invited to deliver expert lectures from 3 August 2013 to 30 August 2013 to the faculty and students of campus on different areas of technology for enhancing the employability of students as well as to expose the faculty and students to the latest developments in the field of Science and Technology .

23. Dr. Akshey Sehgal, an Expert of Global Foundry from New York has delivered an expert lecture on corrosion science on 20 November 2013 to the faculty. He also interacted with the students and guided them for higher study and for their future career.



24. Twelve Faculty Development Programmes (FDP) of 7 days each were organized in the Institute to update the subject knowledge of faculty and providing them practical exposure to the real life problems. In each FDP, more than 40 Teachers have participated.



25. Institute has established the office of Foreign affairs and actively pursuing the case for long term associations with PUM institute

of Netherlands for student and faculty exchange under business link programme of PUM.



26. Eight Faculty Development Programmes were organized by Industry Institute Interaction Cell of the Institute to give practical exposure to the faculty and students about industrial environment, production, finance and marketing problems.

27. The Institute has successfully organized many job fests for all the State Managed Engineering Institutes. This is the only institute among all the state managed engineering colleges which have arranged job fest especially of Infosys. More than 300 students were placed during campus interviews. Further consistent efforts are being made for placement of those who will be graduating in 2014. Our students are getting placed in reputed companies with pay packages ranging from 3 lakhs to 5 lakhs per annum. Infosys has visited the institute for placement in November 2013.



28. The 1st Convocation and 1st Alumni Meet of the institute was held in the year 2010-11 and 2nd Convocation and 2nd Alumni Meet was held on 22.09.2012. Third convocation has been scheduled on 18.02.2014.

29. A national level Tech-fest 'Techno Opus-2014' has been scheduled on 6-8 March 2014.

30. The 113th Birthday of Shaheed Udham Singh was celebrated and seminar was organized in which four eminent speakers had thrown the light on the life history of Shaheed Udham Singh.

31. All hostels of the Institute are equipped with Geysers and Water coolers fitted with RO.



32. In District level Basketball Championship, our girls have won 1st position and got appreciation from District Administration.



33. A Mock Test was organised on 21st Feb, 2013 in the Campus for giving an exposure and creating confidence among the students for appearing JET 2013 competitive exam scheduled on 7 April, 2013. Total 600 students from Punjab appeared in this Mock Test.



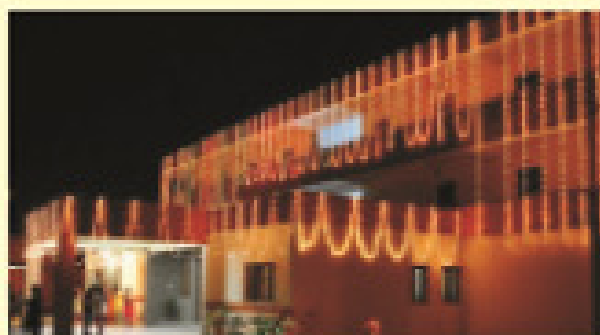
34. The Institute had organized PTU Football Championship.

41. Glowing sign boards have been installed for each building, hostel, residential areas and for other utilities.

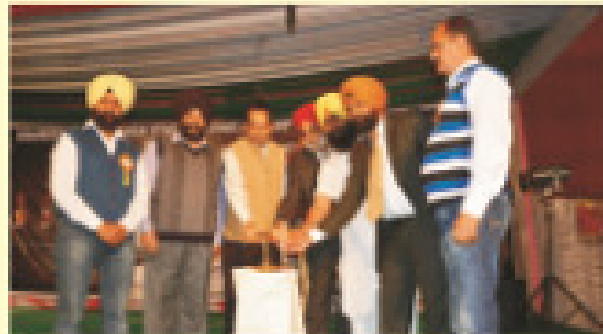
42. Quotable quotes have been displayed at different locations for encouragements and motivation to staff and students.
