1. Applications are invited from **UNMARRIED MALE** engineering degree students studying in <u>pre final year</u> (III year) in academic session 2014-15 for Grant of Permanent Commission in the Army.

- (a) <u>Nationality:</u> A candidate must either be : (i) A citizen of India, or (ii) A subject of Bhutan, or (iii) A subject of Nepal, or (iv) a Tibetan refugee who came over to India before the 1st of January 1962 with the intention of permanently settling in India or (v) a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka and East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania, Zambia, Malawi, Zaire and Ethopia and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India. Provided that a candidate belonging to categories (ii), (iii), (iv) and (v) above shall be a person in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been issued by Government of India. Certificate of eligibility will however not be necessary in the case of candidates who are Gorkha subjects of Nepal.
- (b) Age Limit: 18 24 years at the time of commencement of course. (Candidate born between 2nd Jul 91 and 1st Jul 97 both dates inclusives). The date of birth will be accepted by the office is that entered in the Matriculation or an equivalent examiation certificate
- $\underline{\text{NOTE}}$: No other document relating to age will be accepted and no subsequent request for its change will be considered or granted.
- (c) <u>Educational Qualification</u>: candidates studying in the Pre-Final of the Engineering Course in recognized Universities/Institution/Colleges in the subject mention in para 3 below will be eligible to apply but must possess the education qualification at the time of joining training or should be able to produce the proof of having obtained the educational qualification within 12 weeks from the date of commencement of training for the grant of Permanent Commission in the Army. The candidates who are unable to produce the Degree/Provisional Degree certificate at the time of joining the training will be inducted on Additional Bond Basis for recovery of the cost of training in case they fail to produce the requisite Degree/Provisional Degree Certificate within 12 weeks from the date of commencement of training. (d) Army HQ reserves the right to short list applications and to fix cut of percentage of marks for the SSB interview based on aggregate percentage marks scored by the candidates in the first two years of the engineering degree course.

4. TYPE OF COMMISSION:

- (a) <u>Grant of Commission</u>: Selected candidates will be granted Short Service Commission probation in the rank of Lt from the date of commencement of the course or the date of reporting at IMA, whichever is later and will be entitled to full pay and allowances admissible to Lt during training period. Pay & allowances will be paid after successful completion of
- **(b)** <u>Permanent Commission:</u> On successful completion of training cadets will be granted Permanent Commission in the Army in the rank of Lt.
- (c) Ante Date Seniority: One year ante date seniority from the date of commission will be granted to Engineering UES Entry.
- 5. TRAINING: Duration of training is one year:
- (a) Selected candidates will be detailed for training at Indian Military Academy, Dehradun according to their position in the final order of merit up to the number of vacancies available
- (b) Candidates neither be allowed to marry during the period of training nor he be allowed to live with parents/Guardians. A candidate who marries during training shall be discharged and will be liable to refund all expenditure incurred on him by the government. A candidate, who marries subsequent to the date of his application, though successful, will not be selected for training
- (c) <u>COST OF TRAINING</u>: The entire cost of training is at Government expense. In case the GC is withdrawn from training academy due to reasons other than Medical ground or the reasons not beyond his control, he will be liable to refund cost of training @ Rs. 8135/-per the period of his stay at Indian Military Academy.

6. PAY AND ALLOWANCES: The candidates will be given a stipend of Rs. 21,000/- p.m. (Rs 15,600/- as pay in Pay Band plus Grade Pay of Rs. 5,400/-).
